There is no admission charge. A full range of entertainment and workshops will be announced. Grammy-nominated lutenist Ronn McFarlane strives to bring the lute the most popular instrument of the Renaissance into today's musical mainstream and make it accessible to a wider audience. Born in West Virginia, Ronn grew up in Maryland. At 13, upon hearing "Wipeout" by the Surfaris, he fell madly in love with music and taught himself to play on a "cranky \$16 steel string guitar." Ronn kept at it, playing blues and rock music on the electric guitar while studying classical guitar. He graduated with honors from Shenandoah Conservatory and continued guitar studies at Peabody Conservatory before turning his full attention and energy to the lute in 1978. Jody Marshall, a native of the Washington, D.C. area, grew up in a musical family. Enchanted by the sound and visual appeal of the hammered dulcimer, she developed a passion for the instrument. She has been performing and teaching dulcimer since 1988 and was a founding member of the popular folk trios, Ironweed and MoonFire. She also performed extensively with Connemara. Her debut solo album, "Cottage in the Glen," was released by the Maggie's Music label in Spring 2005. Andrea Hoag takes an uncommon musical path and revels in the connections she makes along the way. With over 30 years of devotion to traditional fiddle styles, including intensive study in Sweden and a Grammy-nominated album, Andrea has earned an international reputation as both tradition-bearer and innovator.?
